Review the material from the previous lessons using the soundletter deck, the high-frequency word deck, and the dry-erase boards.

Make the sounds with your student and have your student write the lowercase letters of this sound on a whiteboard three times while saying the sound. Create a flashcard for the sound-letter deck:

ea (which makes the long "a" sound, as in "great," or the "air" sound as in "bear")

eigh (which makes the long "a" sound, as in "neighbor")

Words to read and write with eigh:

eight neighborhood neigh eighteen weigh

Words to read and write with ea:

break steak wear greatest tear outbreak underwear bear

Introduce the new high-frequency word you have written onto a flashcard. Have the student write the high-frequency word three times while pronouncing the word:

restaurant1

¹ **restaurant**: "restaurant" has three syllables; **res** is decodable; **tau** makes a schwa "tih" sound and is irregular; **rant** is decodable (with **a** making an "ah" sound)
Shove

Have the student read:

That <u>restaurant</u> makes <u>the</u> best steak sandwich and curly fries I have ever had.

When Bill turns eighteen he plans to join the Navy.

In France it is <u>usual to</u> travel <u>to</u> neighboring villages by train. In the U.S., <u>there</u> aren't as <u>many</u> passenger trains.

Have the student write from your dictation:

The teacher began to talk about homework for the weekend and the students said, "Oh, come on, give us a break!"

<u>There was</u> a small tear in Jake's leather jacket but it <u>was</u> still wearable.

Joyce likes diners and <u>restaurants</u> that have cozy booths.

Choose any of the stories in Group 9 (Soft "c" and "g" Stories), Group 8 ("Y" as a Vowel Stories), Group 7 (Consonant-le Stories), or Group 6 (Snow, Cow, Cloud Stories) for a "triple read."
